## JAPAN PILE FACTORY

Watanabe Pile was founded in 1963.  
 The factory is located in a very beautiful area between the mountains with a faint scent of salt from the Seto Inland Sea. Even during the rainy season, there is not much rainfall, it is a very refreshing place.  
 The second-generation master, Fumio Watanabe, welcomed me.  
 When you enter the factory, you will find a pile loom and another loom connected to the thread for the stretched pile. Unlike ordinary looms, jacquard looms are warp threads that hang from the ceiling that looks like a tipi.  
 On the far left is a jacquard pile power loom, which is rare in modern times.  
 The factory manager showed me the movement and told me it is still working fine..  
 There are also an Old-fashioned punch cards hang from the ceiling.  
 Recently, the people making punch cards are severely decreasing and if you ask for a new production, The factory manager explains that it will take at least six months to a year until delivery.  
 Every time the shuttle moves three times, 2mm of pile rises. It's just a repetition, but I heard that the sound of the shuttle sliding is eternal.  
 New machines can easily make good ones in less time, but the slow and careful production of the old machines gives a distinct value to it.  
 Fumio has experience studying abroad and is good at implementing  
 It is a long-established pile factory that is paying attention to the new challenges.  
 We must keep our eye on their proud craftsmanship in the near future.

What is as scary as global warming is that there will be more periods of extremely heavy rain and, conversely, no rain.

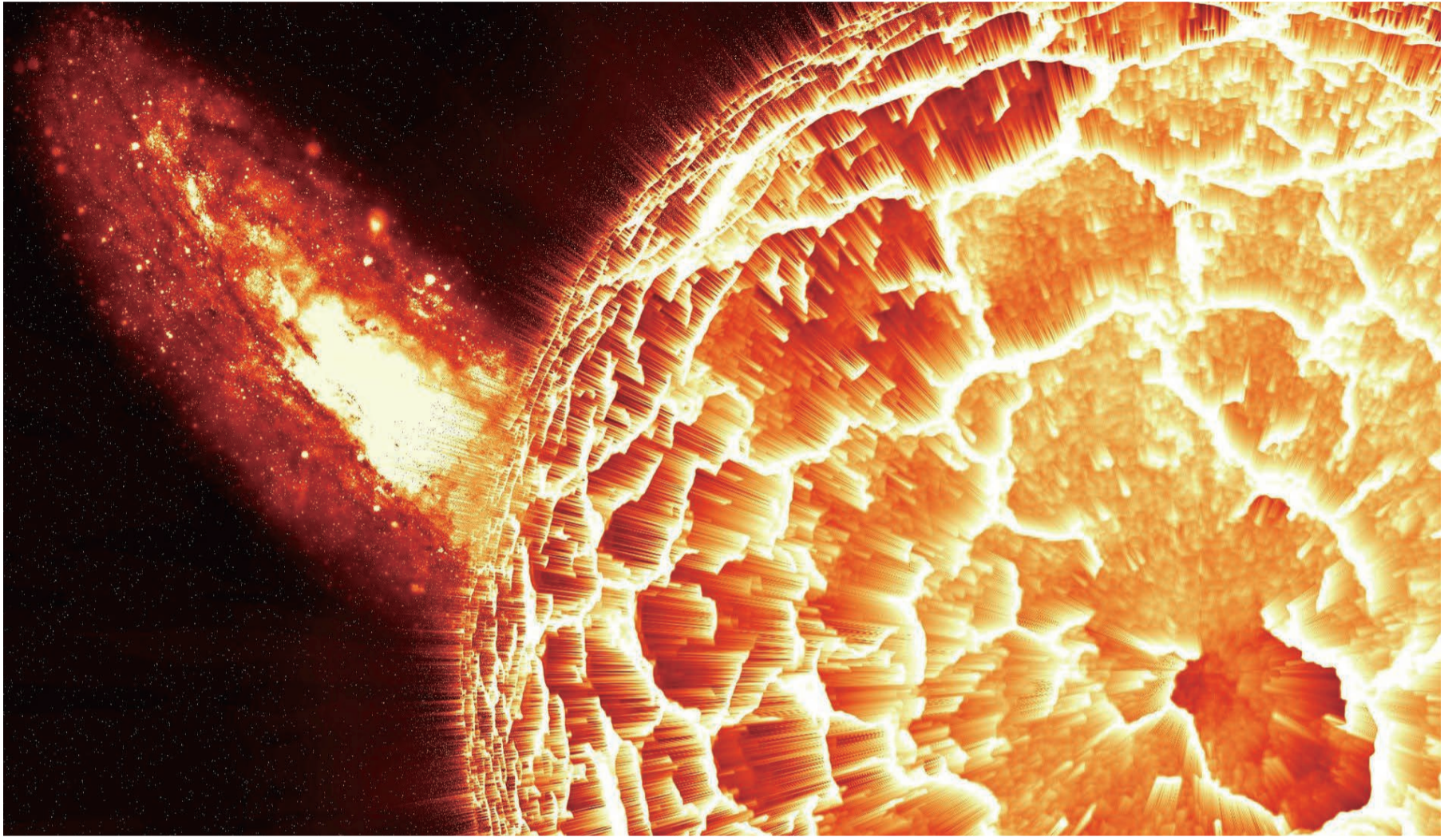

## KATSUIHIRO OTOMO'S ORIGINAL "AKIRA" FORESIGHT PROVED WRONG?



Japanimation's monumental "AKIRA" is said to have foreseen the cancellation of the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. Certainly, the Tokyo Olympics were never held in 2020.



"In 1982, a new bomb exploded in Tokyo, which triggered the outbreak of World War III. When the war ended, Tokyo, where a huge explosion created a huge crater and most of it was submerged, "Neo Tokyo", have started the road of reconstruction. The city ahead of the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, a battle over a child with tremendous supernatural powers called "AKIRA" began.

Yes, this work foresaw that "TOKYO 2020" would be held more than 30 years ago.

For example, in the second volume of "AKIRA", the construction site of the stadium of the Tokyo Olympics is drawn, but there is a sign saying "413 days countdown" and "Demand of cancellation" Graffiti can be seen.

June 7, 2019 is exactly 413 days before July 24, 2020, when TOKYO 2020 opening ceremony was scheduled. In response, the opposition to the Olympics raised criticisms such as "I was able to escape properly while remaining gray" and "I should cancel the black Olympics!"

In "AKIRA", you can see a depiction reminiscent of the new coronavirus turmoil that is causing confusion not only in Japan but also in the world.

The sign says "147 days until the event", and in addition "Demand for cancellation", there is also a graffiti called "Crush".

When exactly is the 147 days before the Olympics in the real world? February 28th. It was the day when the number of people identified as "positive" on the Diamond Princess surpassed 700, raising the risk of a global pandemic to the highest level.

Although it was a prediction that the Olympic Games would be canceled at "AKIRA" explained so far, the IOC and the Japanese Olympic Committee promoted the holding and declared the Olympic Games to be held one year later. It will be held on July 23, 2021 with no audience.

Along with the support of Japan holding its own country, Japan has won the largest number of 58 medals in history.

The number of people infected with COVID-19 in Tokyo increased severely during the event. In August 13, 5,773 people were confirmed positive in Tokyo, the highest number counted in the country.

2021 is also the year when each country started taking the corona vaccine. GAFA has a management system in place with nano-microchips mixed in the vaccine.

It is no exaggeration to say that the current computerization, various gadgets, and applications started from here.

Keyless, cashless, abolition of card ID, AI, while the world is becoming more convenient, the people's thoughts are hacked and freedom of speech and freedom of action is being lost.

As a results, it may be right that the Olympics should have been canceled as predicted by "AKIRA".

## COTOH TSUMI

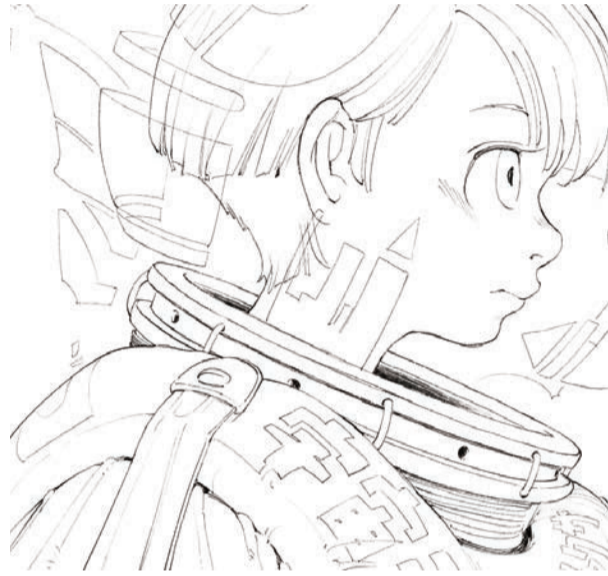
"Oh, I can only draw girls. I can only draw nice people."

# CRAFTSMEN WHO PRAYED FOR JAPANESE TRADITION AND REVITALIZATION

"Nipoaloha" is a brand that inspires the young people who inherit traditional crafts.

While there are sublimation transfer, inkjet, and simple and inexpensive printing methods, we dare to pray for the trust and succession of hand-printing by Kyoto kimono craftsmen.

This time, we will collaborate with "SEVESKIG" for the first time.

A new and old collaborative product that combines the tradition of Nipoaloha with the cut jacquard that SEVESKIG is well known.

Bold and meaningful printing is applied to use the 3rd edition in one color shade.

The base fabric is cut jacquard carefully woven in Kiryu City, Gunma Prefecture, which used to be a silk producing area (now known as a polyester weaving area because the demand for expensive silk has disappeared).

The feature is 100% rayon.

Rayon is a chemical fiber, but it is a recycled fiber that uses natural pulp and raw materials.

Unlike synthetic fibers made from petroleum such as polyester, when they are processed and then buried in soil, they are basically biodegraded into water and carbon dioxide by microorganisms. When incinerated, it is basically decomposed into water and methane.

It is said that SEVESKIG chose this fiber in hopes of regenerating Japan that was damaged by traditional crafts, craftsmen, and corona.

The base cut jacquard pattern is inspired from the tiger of Kuwagata Keisai.

Masayoshi Kitao (1764 – 1824) is an ukiyo-e artist in the middle of the Edo period. It is also known as Kuwagata Keisai.

At that time, he was a painter who was so highly evaluated, and people said, "I hate Hokusai but I like Keisai."

The hand-printed pattern on the Nipoaloha side is a map of Hokusai Katsushika.

"Saiguruzu" is a hand-drawn ukiyo-e painting by Katsushika Hokusai, an ukiyo-e artist in the late Edo period.

Hokusai's 80-year-old work depicts a watermelon with a nakiri bōchō on a vertically long screen, and is considered to be a mitate-e of Tanabata.

Currently in the Sannomaru Shozokan collection of the Imperial Household Agency.

The fabric was finished with the effect of putting the Hokusai pattern on the Hokusai pattern, which was described as "I hate Hokusai and like Hokusai."

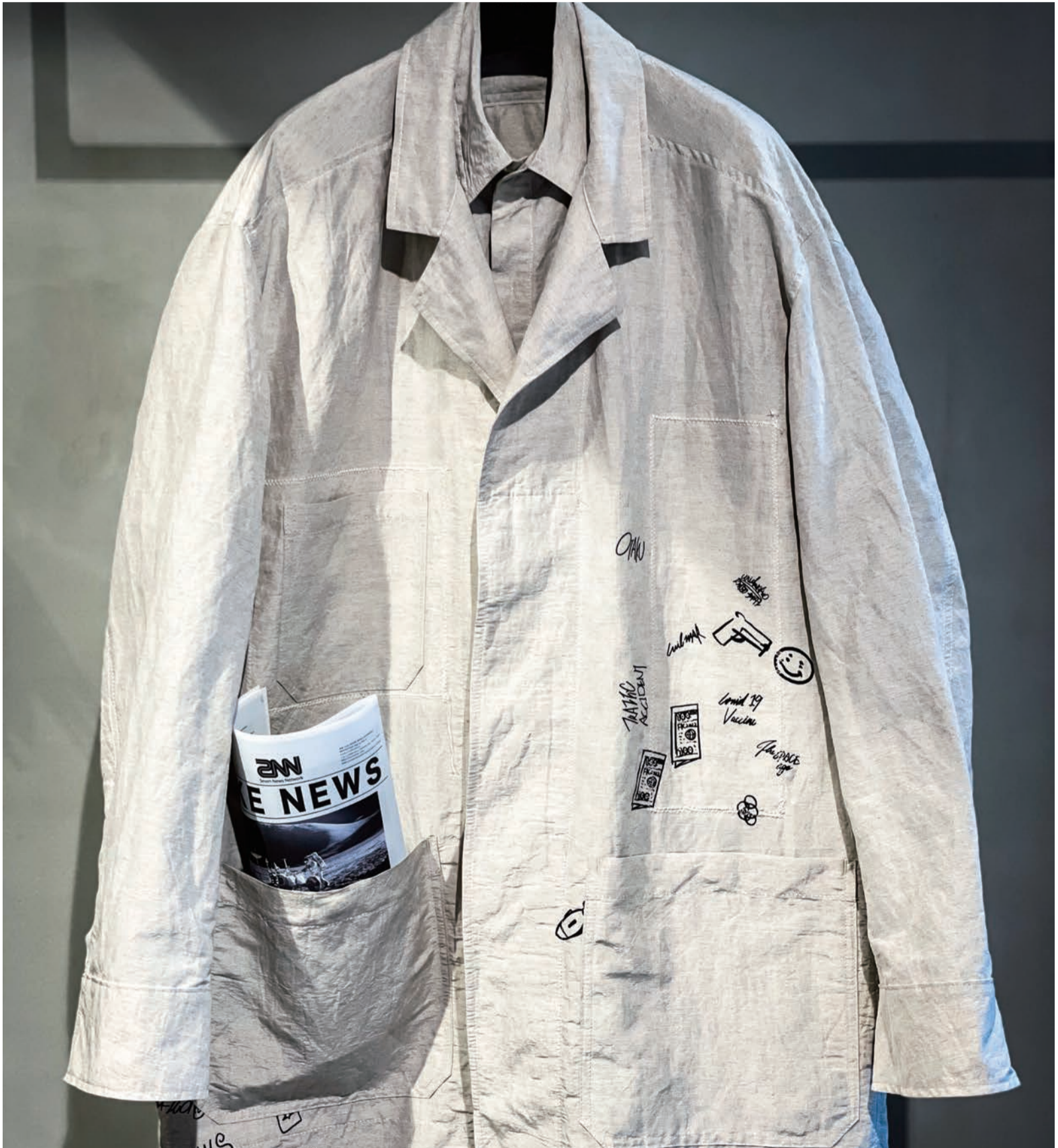
